Once you have decided to return, IOM can help you get travel documents and arrange your flights.



IOM case workers can meet you at the airport, arrange transport and provide other support to help you get settled.

What will it cost?

If IOM is able to help, you will not have to pay back any assistance you receive. The Australian Government funds IOM to provide information and services for Assisted Voluntary Return.

Can I go to a different country?

IOM can help you return to your country of citizenship or a country where you have right of entry and long-term residence.

How soon can I travel?

IOM will keep you informed about how long it will take to organise everything that is needed for you to return. It can take time to organise a travel document and arrange flights, but this will be done as quickly as can be arranged.
